DEATH OF TED ANDREW FROM NET TEAM



"COME & SEE!" VOCATIONS RETREAT

Is God calling you to be a priest? For some it's a moment of discovery. For most, it's growing awareness that develops over time. For all, it's a moment in time when an internal stirring suggest the next step towards a clearer focus on "God's call in my life". It is not necessarily a call to priesthood, but a call to consider a possibility.

This "Come & See" exploring priesthood retreat is an opportunity for Catholic men (18 and over) to meet priests and seminarians, to hear about how they heard their call, how they discerned what God was asking them and what is involved being a priest and of seminary formation.

The weekend will commence on the morning of Saturday May 18th and will conclude on early afternoon on Sunday May 19th. The location for this retreat is in the National Seminary in St Patrick's College in Maynooth.

All are welcome.




PRAY FOR PILGRIMS
